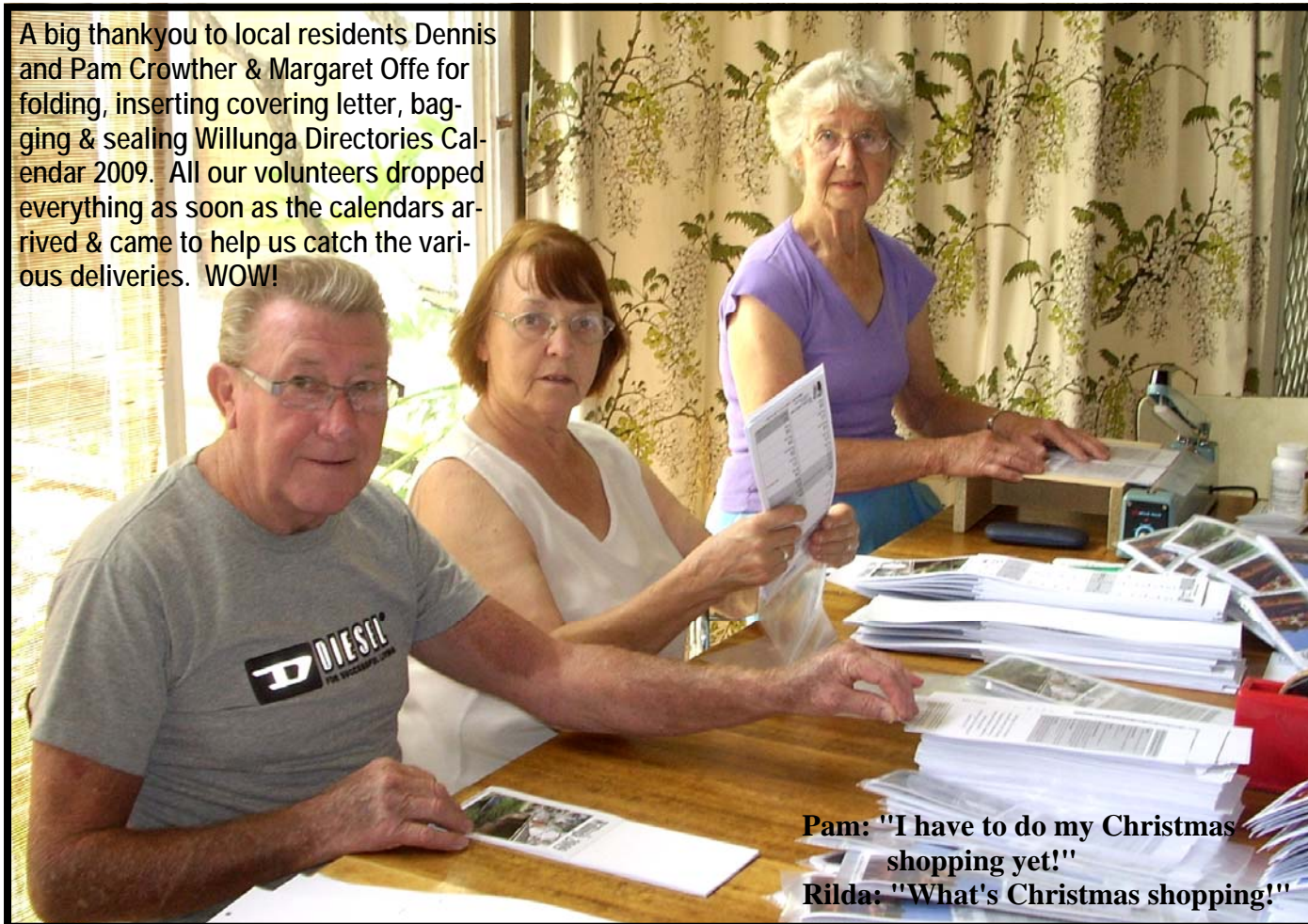

Lance Armstrong in Tour Down Under...



If you didn't see Bradman bat. If you didn't see Ali fight. Don't miss seeing Lance ride... in your own backyard!!

In November 2007 I wrote to Lance Armstrong's manager to see if we could get him to South Australia for the 2009 Tour Down Under. Back then I was hoping he would be part of a motorcade through McLaren Vale and Willunga during the 5th Stage and could speak at a cancer fundraiser.

Of course it is so much better than that, with Lance not only coming to Adelaide, he's coming to ride in the

Tour Down Under in the first race of his much talked-about comeback.

Lance Armstrong won a record seven Tours de France and is considered one of the great athletes of all time.

As a sports journalist for the ABC, I covered Lance's first Tour de France win in 1999 and his Olympic campaign in Sydney 2000. He is a phenomenal athlete and a true professional who fought back from life-threatening cancer to win the world's toughest race seven times. You can see him for free during the Tour Down Under from January 20th-25th including in Aldinga, McLaren Vale and Willunga on Saturday January 24th.

We have secured the longest leg of the Tour Down Under. The 148km fifth stage will start at Snapper Point, Aldinga, head through McLaren Vale and twice over Willunga Hill before finishing in Willunga.

Lance Armstrong's courageously battled an aggressive form of cancer that had attacked his brain, lungs and other parts of his body in 1996. Doctors had given him a 20 per cent chance of survival. In 1999 it was a miracle when he came back from his deathbed to win the Tour de France. He then won the event in each of the next six years, propelling Lance into global sporting legend status. The world's media will be here in their hundreds in January and what a great opportunity to show off our spectacular region as a backdrop to this spectacular athlete.

Lance Armstrong (born 18/9/1971 in Texas) won the Tour de France a record-breaking seven consecutive years, 1999 to 2005. He has survived testicular cancer, a germ cell tumour that metastasized to his brain and lungs, in 1996. Armstrong retired from racing on July 24, 2005, after the 2005 Tour de France, but on September 9, 2008 confirmed he will return to competitive cycling for 2009.

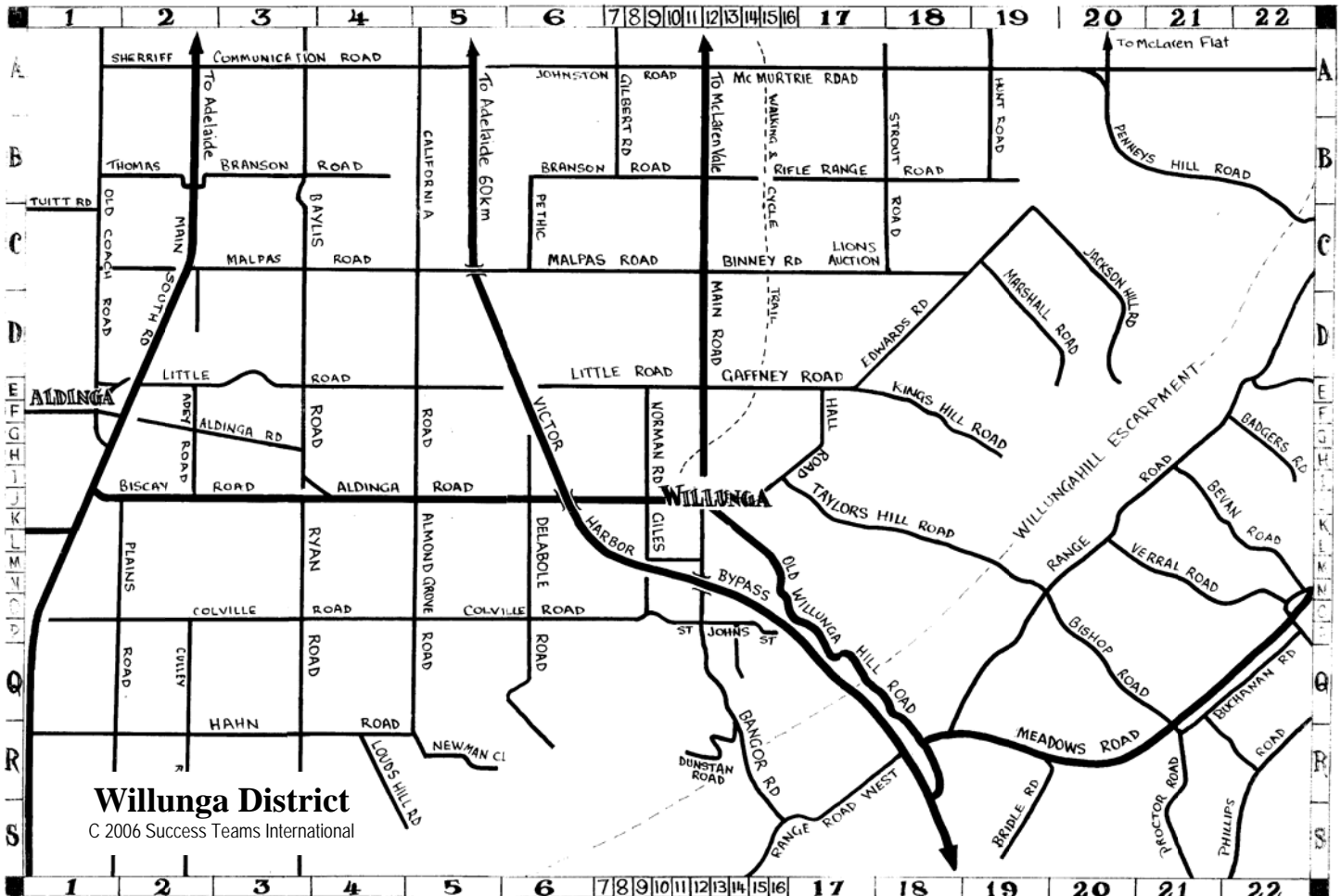
