### Willunga to McLaren Vale Shiraz Trail Labyrinth...

#### Volunteers Wanted

The Shiraz Trail goes between the Old Railway Stations of Willunga and McLaren Vale, following the Walking Trail. The Shiraz Trail committee has been successful in obtaining a grant from Country Arts SA, as part of the 2008 Fleurieu Biennale, for the design and installation of a labyrinth adjacent to the old McLaren Vale railway station site.

The labyrinth will be designed by internationally renowned glass artist Cedar Prest and constructed by volunteers within the community and local schools. Cedar, who will also oversee its installation on the Shiraz Trail, is an acknowledged expert in these ancient meditational structures.

A series of workshops have been planned throughout November to allow community participation in the labyrinth's installa-

tion, with on-site sessions each Saturday and Sunday of the month from 11am to 1pm and 2pm to 4pm on each day.

This will culminate in an alfresco community-opening event on Sunday November 30.

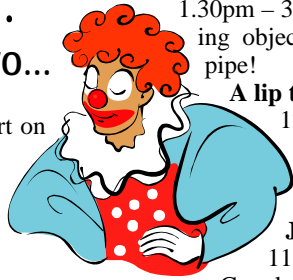

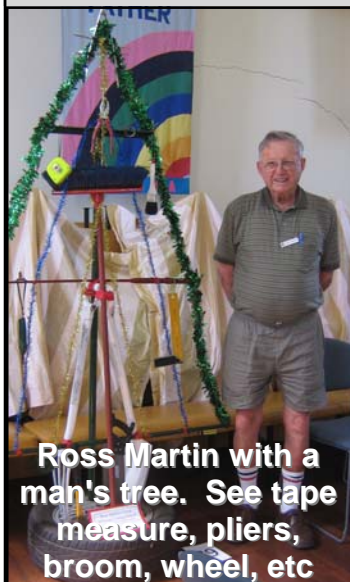

## Showcasing Willunga Neighbourhood Watch...



### Neighbourhood Watch 556 Willunga...

Originally the group was known as Rural Watch 038, but the title was changed to Neighbourhood Watch 556 Willunga in September 2004 to ensure all areas in the State were uniform. And that there was no longer a difference made between rural and metropolitan.

Neighbourhood watch is a joint crime prevention venture between the South Australian Police Department and the community.

At the launch of Neighbourhood Watch, it was stated that one of its main aims was to bring the country to the city; that is, neighbours looking out for each other and their properties. Neighbourhood Watch's main philosophy is that Police Officers cannot be everywhere all the time, so neighbours become their eyes and ears in order to prevent crime and make the community a safer place to live.

With the advent of neighbourhood watch, crime rates have been reduced. Local meetings afford information about crime that is passed on to the relevant group's area. A Police Officer is available to provide that information and answer questions. Meetings are an area where information can be shared.

### Our History...

Neighbourhood Watch for Willunga held its first meeting on the 20th of November 1992, at which time it was established. The local Police Officer, Senior Constable Martin Bazeley convened and 74 people attended. Another 15 apologies were received. An executive committee, zone leaders and deputies were established. Of interest from that meeting was information about a high amount of break-ins and their association with a white vehicle.

Meetings were held bi-monthly in the CWA clubrooms, Main Road until May 1995. In June 1995 meetings were moved to the Uniting Church Hall, St Judes Street where they are still held. Monthly meetings began in September 1996 with the executive meeting separately.

### Benefits to you...

The benefits for having Neighbourhood watch are obvious. Timely information about crime and its trends for the area, alerting residents about what to be aware of. This

makes Willunga a safe and secure area to live. Residents at present have access to three police officers: Senior Sergeant Damien Epps, the officer in charge of the Aldinga Police Station, Sergeant Bob Delaine and Senior Constable Niki Toone. The Watch has also been active in corresponding with local council about things such as adequate street lighting, signage and the removal and pruning of roadside vegetation at intersections.

The long term aim of Neighbourhood Watch is to continue a strong presence within the area and maintain an awareness of crime and crime prevention. People joining the group will benefit from accurate information about policing matters within the area. This includes crime and road safety.

A guest speaker attends each meeting and their chosen field of expertise includes police service, the Australian Red Cross, the Royal Flying Doctor Service and local history to name a few.

### Monthly Meetings...

Meetings are held monthly in the Uniting Church Hall, on the second Monday of the month. Currently the meetings are within the church whilst the new hall is built. The evening concludes with a cuppa and biscuit where there is an opportunity to informally chat.

### Twilight Christmas Concert...

On Monday the 15th of December 2008, the band of the South Australian Police will be performing in the grounds of the old Police Station/Courtroom complex at the top of High Street. Entrance is \$2.

The evening will commence at 6.30pm with two local singers, Mark Delaine and Fiona Bailey singing 'Christmas Jazz'. The Police Band commences at 7.00pm. This concert is a major source of revenue for the group. These concerts have been held in previous years and are extremely popular and well attended.

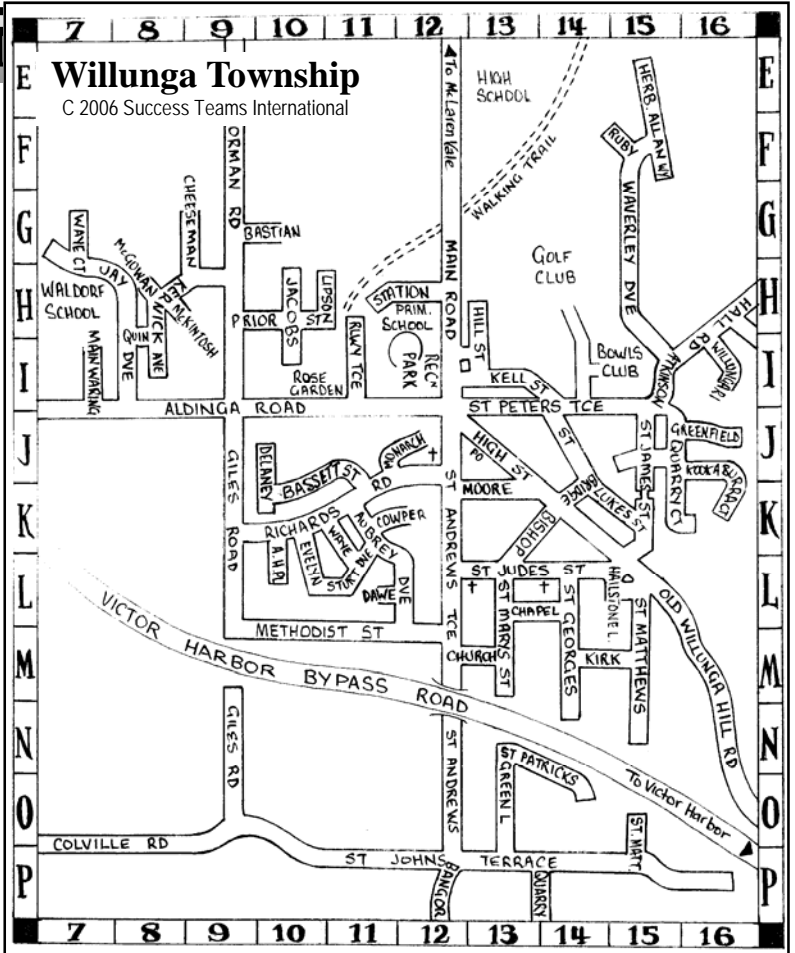

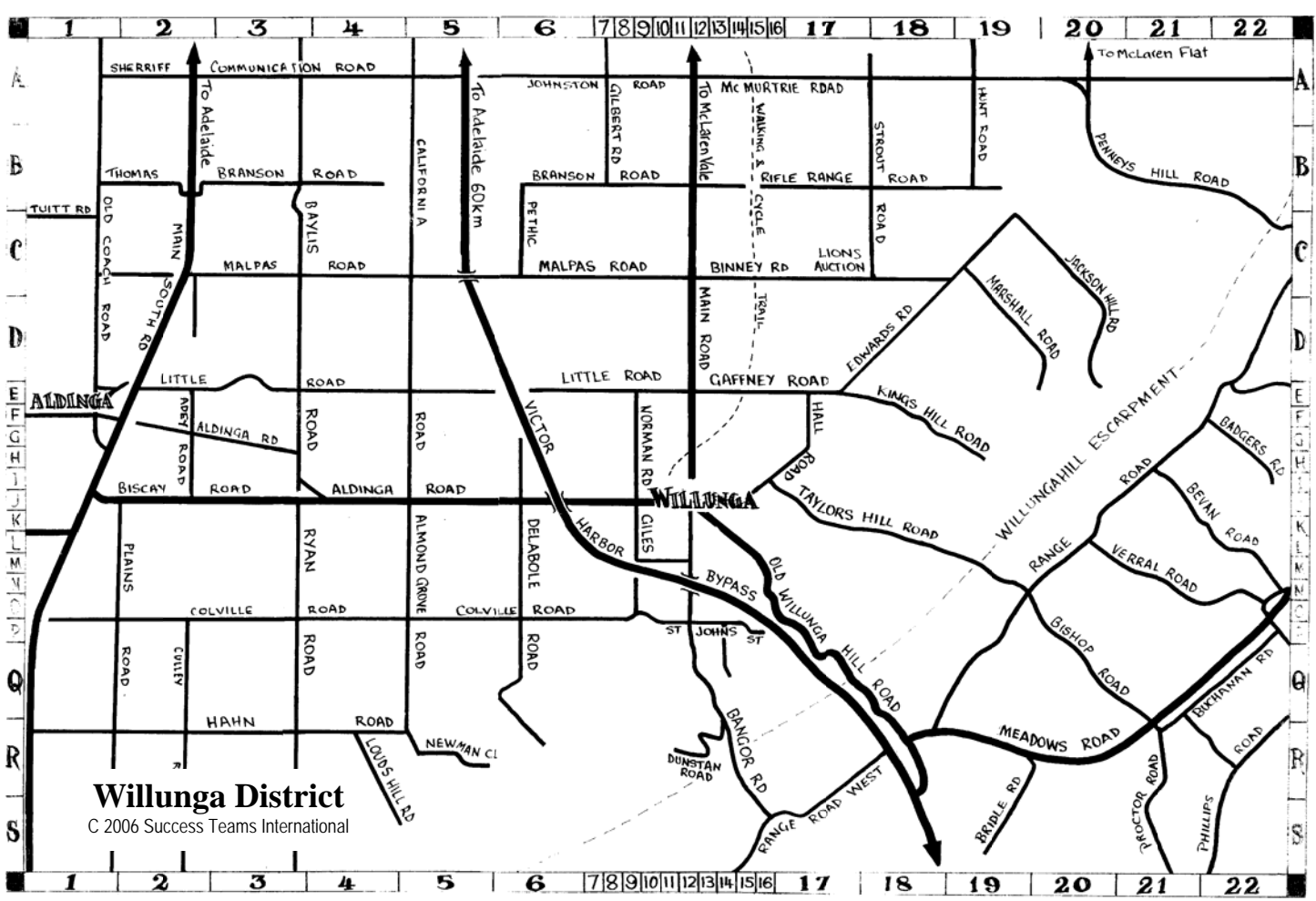
